

## Are your concepts shareable?

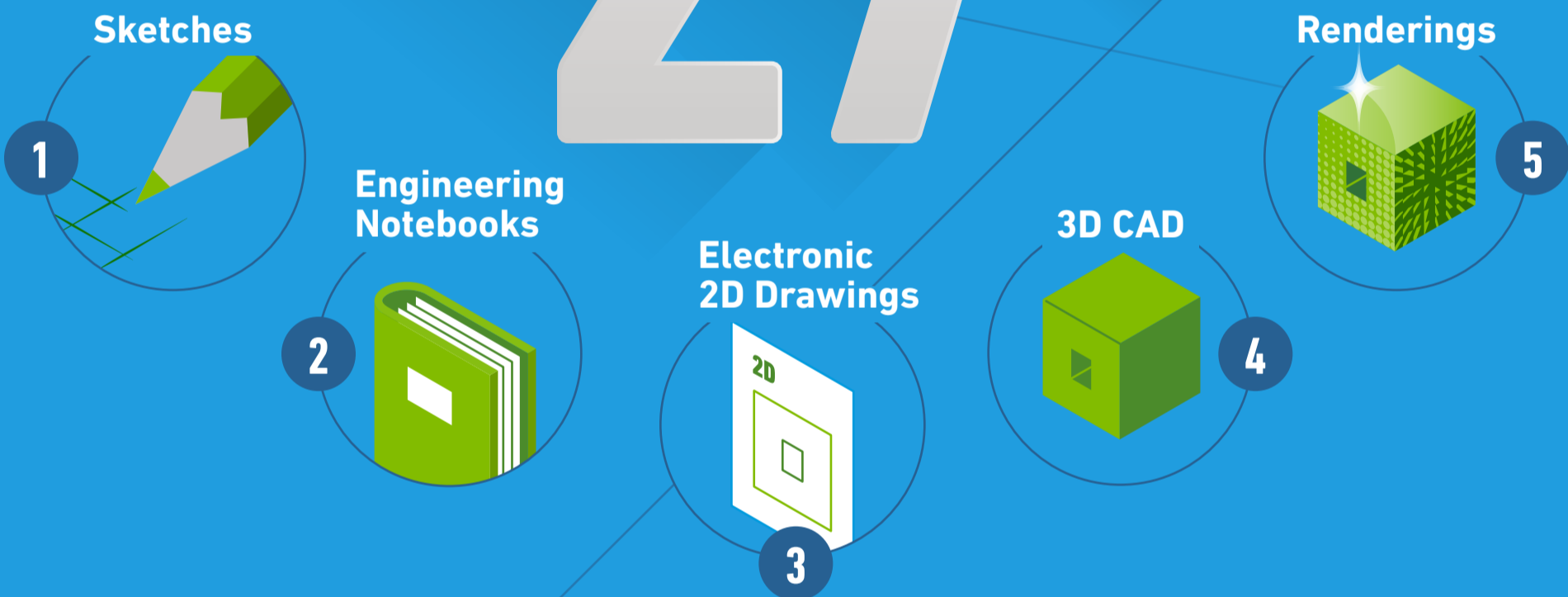
A concept meeting with incompatible design tools is like a dinner party where the guests don't speak the same language...

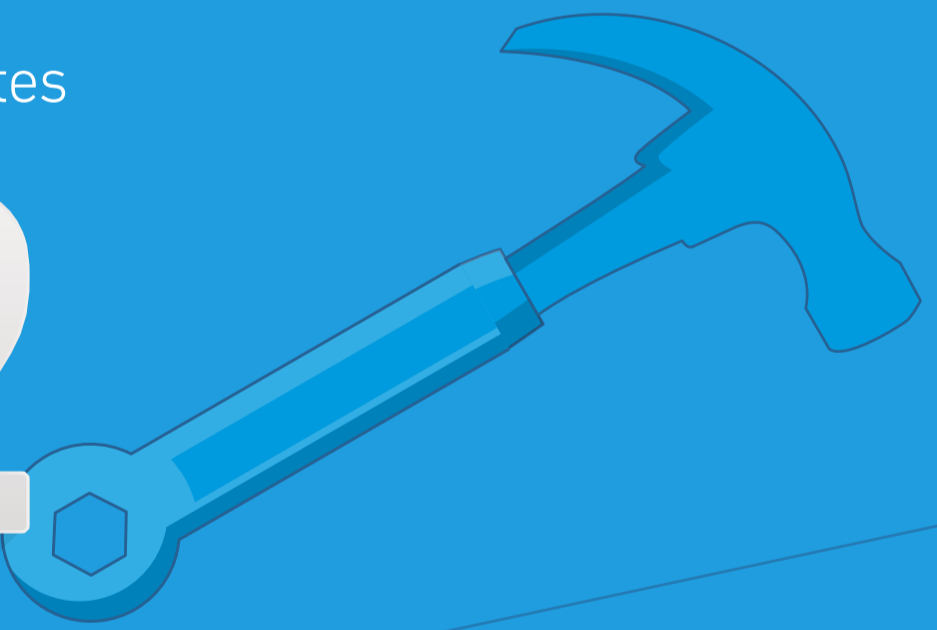


## Integrated tools = higher productivity
