

What is a Self-Guided class?

A Self-Guided class is an alternative option to our instructor-led classes. Students may complete the class materials and lab exercises on their own without live instruction from a PTC University instructor.

Why are Self-Guided classes scheduled?

At this time, we are scheduling all Self-Guided classes to securely manage our VM capacity. You will have 3 hours to complete the class as you would with an instructor-led class.

What materials are included in a Self-Guided class?

Just as with our instructor-led courses, you receive a student guide that contains the class content and walks you through the lab exercises. You will also get access to a VM training computer that you will use to access the lab files required to complete the exercises.
